

THE APTITUDE ASSESSMENT FOR THE SESSION (2021-2022) DELH

SYLLABUS FOR

CLASS : KG-II

Admission to class KG-II will be based on a simple oral & written assessment requiring knowledge of the following:

1. WRITTEN ASSESSMENT:

ALPHABET:

ENGLISH	Recognition and understanding sounds of letters, writing in sequence, dictation, fill-ups, matching and ability to write his/her name in capital letters.
HINDI	Recognition, writing of alphabets and understanding sounds of alphabets. Fill-ups, dictation and matching.

2. NUMBER:

a)	Counting 1 to 20
b)	Recognition of numbers 1 to 20, Backward counting 10 to 1.
c)	Ability to count objects & write the number. Fill-ups within 20.

Identification of colours and shapes. 3. IDENTIFICATION:

a)	COLOURING : Colouring of simple pictures with crayons. The choice of correct colour for the picture will be given credit.
b)	DRAWING: Ability to draw the same picture as shown.

4. PATTERN MAKING: Child's ability to follow any pattern.

5. GENERAL AWARENESS:

a)	Knowledge about himself and members of his family.
b)	Knowledge about his telephone number if any.
c)	Names and recognition of vegetables, fruits, animals, vehicles etc.

6. **OBSERVATION:** VISUAL PERCEPTIION

a)	The child's ability to find out what is missing in a particular picture. For example : Parts of body, Part of an object etc
b)	Ability to point out an object which does not belong to a set of picture.

7. **MEMORY :**

The child will be shown a number of objects for a few seconds and will be asked to tell from memory what he remembers.

8. AURAL SPATIAL PERCEPTION :

a)	The child's ability to repeat sounds, numbers and associating sounds with objects.
b)	Recitation of any poem of his/her choice. Special credit will be given to good expression and choice of poem.

9. **GROUP ACTIVITY:** A child will be observed in a group activity. His ability to socialize, play and make friends will be observed.
